#### **BE PREPARED**

Some reminders for being prepared for any future SNOW events.....

**Shovel your sidewalks and porch clear within 24 hours of a snow storm.** Be certain that you have your shovels and snow/ice melt ready for that first storm. If you are unable to take care of this yourself, make arrangements with a neighbor, friend or hired help to clear the sidewalks for you.

**Remember the postal and package delivery workers**. They need safe, snow/ice free conditions to deliver the mail and/or packages safely to your home.

**Be a good neighbor:** If you have a neighbor who isn't physically able to shovel themselves out after a snow storm, lend them a helping hand by clearing their walks for them.

**Do NOT use sodium chloride/rock salt on your porch or sidewalks.** This destroys the cement. Sand or kitty litter can be used to improve traction on icy surfaces. If you prefer to use an ice-melter, try magnesium chloride or calcium chloride. These products do not damage the porch or sidewalks when properly used.

Your neighbors, delivery and mail personnel, as well as those who walk through our neighborhood will appreciate your thoughtful consideration as well as prevent nasty falls and damaged packages.

#### **ROYAL FARM STORE**

Many residents have been wondering about the status of a new Royal Farms store since the company shared plans with the community earlier last year. Royal Farms has communicated that the plans are still moving forward to build a new store on Edmondson Avenue next to the Crown gas station. Approvals are still needed from the county and that should be completed by this May. Any updates will be communicated to residents at AHCA monthly meetings and minutes

# **RELIEF SEWER PROJECT**

The sewer project began in November, but has had a slow start, partly due to the wet weather. Pipe replacement is currently occurring on Overbrook Road. Over 100 feet of pipe has been installed along with several manholes. A new Project Manager was recently put into place and the county is now having weekly updates with the contractor. Residents will be updated on progress.
